


Last summer, I had a chance to visit the Southern area of Wakayama with my family. It took about three and half hours from Wakayama city by car. When we arrived at a hotel, we saw a group of foreign tourists. I wanted to know where they came from, so I asked them in English. They were from France. Then I saw many foreign tourists in shops, temples, shrines and so on. "There are so many foreign tourists in Wakayama!" I was surprised to know that.

Do you know how many foreign tourists visit Wakayama? I saw the homepage about foreign tourists in Wakayama. I found some interesting things there. First, the number of foreign tourists who stayed in Wakayama in 2013 was 211,754. It was the highest number on record. Second, about half of the tourists were from Taiwan and Hong Kong. The number of tourists from Hong Kong was larger than the number from Taiwan, and France came after them.

I hear that Wakayama is getting famous around the world because there is a World Heritage Site which consists of Koyasan, Kumanokodo and so on. I want to know more about foreign tourists visiting Wakayama. So I'm going to interview them.

Taku: I see. Please tell me how to master English.


Ryan: Sure. B So you did it very well. And I know you study English hard by reading and writing. You should keep studying like that. At the same time, you have to use English as a tool for communication.


